

# RULES FOR RENTING AN E-CHOPPER

With regards to renting an E-chopper from EuroWheelz, please note that the following rules and general terms and conditions apply. (Also available on our website)

The renter agrees that he/she is in agreement with the below:

1. Our cancellation conditions; If you wish to cancel your paid booking, there is no refund possible.
2. The lessee shall be deemed to have received the rented materials in good condition and the lessor shall be deemed to have delivered the materials in good condition.
3. The main lessee is in possession of a valid ID that can be shown upon arrival
4. Lessee is liable for the damage or loss of the E-chopper. The lessee is responsible for the costs of any reparation or replacement of the vehicle.
5. By theft, the total replacement costs of €1.500,- per E-chopper will be charged to the lessee. By the online reservation, the own risk costs can be reduced to € 350,- for a small fee of € 3,50 per E-chopper.
6. In case of return after the agreed return date and time, the lessee will be charged for each hour that the rental item is returned late of an amount of € 50.00 per hour per rental item.
7. Before the ride begins the lessee is required to have paid for the entire booking.
8. The renting / riding of the E-chopper is at your own risk. Fines will also be the lessee's responsibility.
9. In the event of an early return, the full rental will remain in effect, even in the event of a stationary vehicle being stopped or picked up, the full rental will remain in effect. In case of a defect to the E-chopper by the lessee, the costs (€100,-) for picking up the vehicle, will be charged to the lessee.
10. It is forbidden to charge the battery with a non-original charger. Any damage in the event of doing so will be charged to the lessee.
11. The lessee bears full legal responsibility for any damage caused to or by any third parties.
12. EuroWheelz cannot be held responsible for technical defects, damages, fines, explosion in batteries and reckless behaviour.
13. A helmet is mandatory in Europe.
